What is PBIS?

- PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports. PBIS is not a code of conduct, it is a system that allows us all to see and focus on the good in every single student.
- Specifically, PBIS is a positive and proactive systems approach to establishing the behavioral supports and social culture for all students in our school to achieve social, emotional, and academic success.
- Mullica Twp.'s PBIS is committed to positively reinforcing **all** students when they are meeting and exceeding the explicitly taught expectations as outlined by our Coyote Calling- Responsible, Respectful, and Ready- (The 3 R's), on an ongoing basis.

How does PBIS positively reward students?

- Mullica Twp.'s PBIS will be working hard to recognize our students' Coyote Calling actions with the following:
 1. Monthly Events
 2. Surprise School-Wide Events each Trimester
 3. "Leader of the Pack" Recognition
 4. Strong Coyote Cards

What will our events look like?

- Throughout the year we will be rolling out monthly events filled with activities and prizes that all students can attend.
- There will be a separate middle school event and a primary event, to ensure students enjoy grade specific activities.
- **EVERY STUDENT** is eligible to attend! ☺

What is a "Leader of the Pack"?

- The "Leader of the Pack" will be taking the place of "Coyote of the Month."
- A "Leader of the Pack" is considered to be a student who exemplifies the Coyote Calling by exceeding the expectations outlined in our calling (The 3 R's) on a consistent basis and demonstrates actions that are consistent with the character trait of the month. These students are role models, inspiring their peers to follow our Coyote Calling and embody the character trait of the month.
- These students will be recognized at monthly events, receive a t-shirt and receive a certificate.
- One student per homeroom, per month will be nominated.

What about those Strong Coyote Cards?

- This year there will be no more Wounded Coyote cards, only Strong Coyote cards, to ensure we are reinforcing and recognizing the positives in our students.
- Strong Coyote Cards will be rewarded all year long to motivate students to meet the expectations of our Coyote Calling and embody the character trait of the month. Any staff can reward any student with a Strong Coyote Card when the student is seen doing acts that demonstrate the character trait of the month.
- Students can cash in their Strong Coyote Cards at the monthly events to enter in a raffle to win a prize. (One student will be chosen at the primary event and one at the middle event).

What color is my child's class for Color Wars?

- For all PBIS sponsored activities/events, we encourage your class to show school spirit by wearing Coyote gear in your class color, generously provided by the PTA.
