Recently you were notified of problems with the boys and girls group bathrooms near the cafeteria. We would like to provide an update on the situation.

While attempting repairs to the bathrooms, district staff discovered what appeared to be mold in the wall cavity between the boys and girls bathrooms. The bathrooms were immediately closed, secured, and the ventilation to and from the bathrooms was sealed. At the same time, the district contacted 1 Source Safety and Health to test the substances observed in the wall cavity. The results of those tests show evidence of Chaetomium and Stachybotrys molds which grow on wet drywall.

As a result of the testing, the district will conduct a complete and thorough clean-up of both group bathrooms. The clean-up will be conducted by a licensed environmental company. Once the clean-up process is complete, follow-up testing will be conducted before any repair work begins. To ensure the health and safety of students, the district will proactively test the remaining group bathrooms. Those results will be made public when they are available.

Once the bathroom repairs are complete and certified safe for students to use, we will follow up with an announcement. The health and safety of our students, staff, and visitors is our first priority. We kindly ask for patience as we anticipate the entire process will take several weeks to complete.
