On Friday, June 26, 2020 Governor Murphy and New Jersey Department of Education Commissioner Lamont Repollet released The Road Back: Restart and Recovery Plan for Education- click [HERE](#) to view the reopening guidance.

After reviewing the guidance, I am able to report that our district's initial planning efforts put us on the right path to reopen schools in compliance with the provisions of the state plan. Over the next few weeks, we will engage the school community in actions to ensure our staff and students are fully prepared for the reopening.
