Dear School Community,

Since our schools closed in March, teachers, staff, and administration have been preparing for the eventual reopening of schools. At every step and turn along our journey, we have followed Governor Murphy’s executive orders, cooperated with surrounding districts, and developed a reopening plan certified by the Atlantic County Executive County Superintendent.

However, the realities on the ground are filled with many questions and unknowns. Over the past few months we have responded to ever changing guidance, recommendations, and last minute updates. Those situations have a ripple effect on our planning, operations, and academic plans. As we approached September, it became clear that more time was needed to make the necessary adjustments to ensure the health and well-being of our staff, students, and families.

As previously communicated, the start of the 2020-21 school year was pushed back to Monday, September 14th. Last evening the Board approved a revised 2020-2021 school calendar which is attached to this message.

As a reminder Chromebook pick-up is in the back of the school and starts Monday, August 31 (see schedule below). The \$10 usage fee is waived for this year. Any parent who has already paid the fee will be reimbursed following the September 23rd BOE meeting.

Bus passes will be mailed to all students next week. Please note for safety and security reasons every student is assigned to a bus and will receive a bus pass. In the event your child(ren) is not utilizing the bus, you may file the pass. Children riding the bus are reminded to bring their bus pass with them on the first day.

Over the next two weeks, you can expect to receive additional communication from the district, as well as, your principal as we finalize our operational and academic plans for the start of school.
