# OUR PROGRAM

Our 21stCCLC ACES On-Line Application Registration Link:

Our **AM/Morning ACES Program operates IN-PERSON** 1.5 hours (6:45AM-8:15AM) before school Monday - Friday for Cohort A & B students who receive:

- a healthy, nutritious breakfast self-prepared under supervision of our cooking instructor;
- Homework Help and Academic Support;
- Fitness, Yoga/Meditation, Movement Activities (student choice)

Our **PM/Afternoon ACES operates VIRTUALLY** up to 2 hours after school Monday – Friday, with pre-filmed activities available (24/7). PMAfternoon ACES provides:

- Google Classroom LIVE check-in with the Site Coordinator (3:30PM – 3:45PM)
- assignment to Homework Help and Academic Support breakout rooms w/certificated teachers;
- assignment to a hosted breakout room for Academic/STEM Enrichment;
- student option to select from a menu of either virtual “live” activities or pre-filmed instructional activities/clubs via Google Classroom/Hangouts and/or Zoom Platform(s).
- Option for “first-registered, first eligible” participation in specialized, limited-seats programs like our planned Futures First Gaming Club/Team, First Move Chess Club, STEAM FORWARD Academy, Skillastics STEM & Sports Program, and Minecraft Escape Rooms.

**21stCCLC ACES Program** also offers **virtual themed-family activities** on “Wacky Wednesdays” or “Fun Fridays”. These events are often coordinated with the 21stCCLC Egg Harbor City School District REACH Program. Past events have included Welcome Winter Shoebox Car Parade, Virtual Dance Parties, Cardio-Drumming, Yoga and Mindfulness, Parent Kid-Grit Workshop, and Family Pizza Night.

When covid-gathering restrictions are relaxed, **SATURDAY Family and Community Engagement Events** will be scheduled. Think “Afternoon at the Aquatic Center”, “Skating Away Saturday”, “Amazing Day at the Aquarium”, and/or “A Day Down on the (Funny) Farm”. Parents may bring a registered child(ren) and other siblings to enjoy the day as a family, together, hanging out and having fun.
