As we approach Trimester 3, I want to alert you of some opportunities that will be available for your child/ren. If you want to change your child/ren's learning model, you must complete the Trimester 3 Survey. The two learning models are virtual and in person.

Please note, a change in your child's learning model, e.g., in person to virtual or virtual to in person, may result in a homeroom change. If you elect to change from in person to virtual or virtual to in person, the change will occur on Monday, March 22, 2021. No changes will be made after March 22, 2021.

Outlined in the District's initial Return to Learning – Next Steps Plan, the final phase called for five days of in-person or virtual instruction while maintaining the current daily schedule of 8:30-12:34.
