- January 24th Meditation & Mindful Movement Workshop 5PM 6:45PM Cafeteria
 - Parents, MTSD Staff and Adult Community Members are welcome to attend an adult school community workshop lead by educator and Peace Circle/Mindfulness Consultant Carolyn Corbi. Peace Circles and meditation intentionally create a space that lifts internal and external barriers between people, opening fresh possibilities for connection, collaboration and mutual understanding and well-being. Participants will engage in mindful practice and movement activities.

FIELD TRIP

Our next field trip is scheduled for January 19th and takes place during the school day. Students will travel to The Franklin Institute in Philadelphia, PA. They will tour the museum and attend a special FI Demonstration show on combustion. Student eligibility to participate in this trip is based on regular attendance in the ACES Program (45+ days) and a record of positive behavior, with NO disciplinary incidents or reports during the school day, as well as ACES. Only 60 seats are available for eligible students. Parents will sign-up their child for the trip through a PAPER RSVP/Reservation Form. This form will be given ONLY to eligible students. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Nita M. Lowey 21stCCLC Mullica Township School ACES Program provides Mullica Township resident students in Grades 3-12 with quality "out of school time" academic support, instructional programs, and activities. Mullica ACES collaborates with grant-approved organizations and community groups to provide a safe environment where opportunities in academic remediation and enrichment, positive youth development, culture and the arts, health, nutrition & fitness, and physical activity - as well as opportunities for parental involvement - are offered. In addition, ACES also provides positive social and emotional experiences to promote the academic success of all students.

All ACES Programming is intentionally designed to provide our students with a broad array of experiences to complement and supplement the regular school day academic programs and school services. Parent Programs and Workshops will also be offered. AM Morning and PM Afternoon ACES will:

- infuse SEL and life skill opportunities into our programs.
- incorporate more "physical movement for life" activities.
- provide remediation and enrichment opportunities to support student learning.
- expand STE(A)M offerings through added robotics, coding, and problem-solving opportunities.
- Promote student voice and equity in education.
